1. **Date and Place of Meeting:** 8th – 10th March 2019 at Kartsport Canterbury, Carrs Rd, Christchurch

Track Name Carrs Road Raceway

Track Direction Friday & Saturday – Clockwise / Sunday – Anticlockwise

Track Length 680 metres approx.

2. **The groups for parade/demonstration runs will be:**

1. 60s
2. 70's
3. 80's
4. Supers (karts over 100cc)
5. Era 5
6. Midget: 6 to under 11 years Midget Karts
7. Junior Restricted; 9 to under 13 years;
8. Juniors: 12 to under 16; single engine 100cc piston port powered engines
 - Note: Depending on numbers Junior Classes may be combined and run as a "parade".
 - Note: Depending on numbers Senior groups may be combined on track
 - Note: Senior minimum age 15 years.
 - A senior "Ladies and Gents" class may be offered for those drivers who wish to proceed at a slower pace than the general group.

3. **Entry details as per official entry form.**

- All participants should be VKNZ members and must hold a current Kartsport New Zealand Vintage Licence, a current Kartsport New Zealand Competition Licence or a valid ASN Licence and Visa from another country. Official entry/indemnity/declaration form must be completed, signed and returned to event secretary with payment of all fees.
- Vintage Karts must be a minimum of 25 years old and use SL or control type tyres i.e. current control tyre in NZ is Dunlop.
- Helmets and Clothing must comply with Kartsport New Zealand Rule V5. i.e. suitable suit lined and fastened at wrists and ankles. No domed boiler suits. One piece leather suits min 1.2mm may be used unlined. All suits must have drivers Christian and Surname printed or embroidered on them.
- Period clothing and open face helmets are only permitted in "parades".
- All Karts/engines must be recorded on the VKNZ Register and it is the Owners responsibility to verify the year and model of their kart/engine.
- The maximum rear width for all karts is 1250mm; unless there are sufficient Supers and 1980's plus entrants to run either separate or combined classes - for these karts where the maximum width will be 1300mm.

4. Format for Parade/Demonstration Runs:

Runs will start from the pits as best possible fastest to the front. Groups may be split on number, speed differentiation, ability and attitude. There will be a Driving Standards Officer (Clerk of Course) and a "3 strikes and you are out" policy. There will be no prizes for the event.

5. Driver's Briefing: Will be conducted on the Saturday and Sunday, on the out grid, or other such place as may be notified. All drivers (and their parents/legal guardians if the driver is under 18 years old) must attend each briefing.

6. Kart Stands: All kart stands are required to have feet attached to prevent damage to the sealed pit and dummy grid area

7. Security: Overnight Security will be at the track on Friday and Saturday nights. Kartsport Canterbury and Vintage Karting New Zealand Inc. will not be held liable for any loss or damage incurred.

8. Cafeteria and Bar Facilities:

- Lunches and light refreshments available during the day on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.
- Breakfast will be available on Saturday and Sunday.
- Friday Evening light meal & refreshments. Tickets for purchase on Entry form.
- Main function will be Saturday night at The Bealey. Tickets for purchase on Entry form.
- EFTPOS facilities are available at the kitchen and bar (**NO** Credit Cards accepted).
- The bar will be open only after the completion of practice / Demonstrations and the track has closed for the day.

Note: As a condition of the bar licence, the only alcohol to be consumed within the Kartsport Canterbury grounds is that which is purchased from the Clubrooms. Thank you for your co-operation with this.
